2. ENTRY FEES

2.1. Entry fee will be £25

3. SCHEDULE AND RACING FORMAT

3.1. Registration will be held in the Bowmoor clubhouse from 09.30 on Saturday. A competitor briefing will be held at 11.30 Saturday morning in the clubhouse.

3.2. **Race Format** - Four back to back races are scheduled for Saturday with the first race start not before 12.00. Two back to back races are scheduled for Sunday with the first race start not before 10.00

5. OTHER INFORMATION

5.1. Campers and camper vans are welcome. All day galley on both days

5.3. Entrants and authorised guests are temporary members of Bowmoor Sailing Club during the period of the event and shall comply with Club Rules and Bylaws. Failure to observe these may result in exclusion from the club premises.

5.4. MOVEMENT OF BOATS TO BOWMOOR SC

In order to prevent the spread of non-native species there is a requirement to ensure that boats are clean before they visit the site using the principle of Check Clean Dry <http://www.nonnativespecies.org/checkcleandry/index.cfm>. This includes:

CHECK your equipment and clothing for live organisms – particularly in areas that are damp or hard to inspect.

CLEAN and wash equipment, footwear and clothing thoroughly. If you do come across any organisms, leave them at the water body where you found them.

DRY all equipment and clothing – some species can live for many days in moist conditions. Make sure you don't transfer water elsewhere.
