

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - APPENDIX A – COURSE DIAGRAMS

RS 100 Windward Leeward Course Diagram

L	COURSE: WINDWARD/LEEWARD with reaching finish
Signal	Mark Rounding Order
L2	Start - 1 - 1a - 4s/4p - 1 - 1a - 4p - Finish
L3	Start - 1 - 1a - 4s/4p - 1 - 1a - 4s/4p - 1 - 1a - 4p - Finish
L4	Start - 1 - 1a - 4s/4p - 1 - 1a - 4s/4p - 1 - 1a - 4s/4p - 1 - 1a - 4p - Finish

T2	Start - 1 - 2 - 3 - 5 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 5 - Finish
T3	Start - 1 - 2 - 3 - 5 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 5 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 5 - Finish
T4	Start - 1 - 2 - 3 - 5 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 5 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 5 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 5 - Finish
Note	The start line is not part of the course after the start
