Notice of Race

These Notice of Race are published to give information that is common to all virtual events organised by the UK RS 200 Class Association.

1 RULES

1.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the Virtual Regatta Inshore Application. There will be no allowance for protests outside of the game.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

2.1 All notices to competitors will be sent via WhatsApp group messages detailing start times and flights.

3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any change to the Notice of Race will be posted on the Facebook event and messaged to the group WhatsApp.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1 Competitors will be messaged the start time of the first race and the password to enter.

5 FORMAT OF RACING

- 5.1 The format of racing will be in fleets, each consisting of no more than 20 boats. and a single series provided that a Medal Race may be organised if necessary in the event of a tie for medal positions.
- 5.2 The fleets will be allocated and competitors will be notified of their fleet via WhatsApp before 10pm on the day before racing.

6 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 6.1 Racing will take place on Saturday 18th April and Sunday 19th April. A Medal race consisting of the top 19 ranked boats plus one organiser boat will take place on Monday 20th April to decide the winner from a three race series.
- 6.2 First race of the day will be at 09:00 on Saturday and Sunday.
- 6.3 The format for the event is that there will be no more than 12 races in total during fleet racing.
- 6.4 When more than one race will be held on the same day, the warning signal for the second and each succeeding race will be made as soon as practicable.

7 SCORING SYSTEM

- 7.1 Each boat will receive the number of points equivalent to her place in her respective flight. Flights will be reallocated for Day Two.
- 7.2 For this event:

- a) When 11 or less races have been completed a boats series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- b) When from 12 races have been completed a boats series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 7.3 Medal Race scoring:
- a) A competitor qualifying for the Medal Race will carry her position from the overall standing forward. Then all 3 races of the Medal Race Series will count. With final results being the qualifying position and Medal Race Series results added together.

8 PRIZES

- 8.1 Prizes will be awarded as follows:
- a) First overall.

9 NAVIGATIONAL AIDS

9.1 Use of GPS and navigation software is banned. (Best VMG, Time to line etc). Any infringements to this rule will result in a DSQ being awarded for all races.
