#### **To be read in conjunction with the RS Association Standard Sailing Instructions**

#### **3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS**

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the east entrance lobby of the clubhouse

#### **5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the main flagpole. The main flagpole is located on the west end of the club lawn.
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP. This changes race signals AP.

#### **7 CLASS FLAGS**

RS300      RS300 Class Flag or if not available Numeral 3 or Flag T

#### **9 COURSES**

- 9.1 Courses to be sailed will be as designated by the race officer and displayed on the course board in front of the clubhouse.

#### **10 MARKS**

Marks 1 to 6 will be Orange spherical buoys. An additional yellow spherical buoy may be used. The start mark will be a mark of the course adjacent to the committee boat; the finish mark will be a mark of the course adjacent to the committee boat.

#### **11 OBSTRUCTIONS**

Shallows in front of the club, which are marked with small orange buoys, are an obstruction.

#### **17 HEARING REQUESTS**

- 17.4 Hearings will be held in the protest room at the clubhouse.

#### **19 SAFETY REGULATIONS**
