3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the conservatory of the club house.

5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the main flagpole. **On the beach**

5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 20 minutes' in Race Signals AP. This changes race signals AP.

7 CLASS FLAGS

RS300 - RS300 Class Flag or if not available **Numeral X**

9 COURSES

9.1 Courses to be sailed will be Windward Leeward, Trapezoid or triangle, The diagrams in Addendum A show the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be passed.

9.2 The courses to be sailed will be indicated by boards on the side of the committee signal vessel.

10 MARKS

Marks 1- 6 and P will be fixed black buoys. X & Y buoys are round coloured buoys. The start mark will be a buoy with an orange flag, the finish mark will be a buoy with a blue flag, OR a fixed black buoy. Racing will be carried out on the Sea directly to the West of the clubhouse.

The diagram above shows the approximate position of the maximum static marks for Sea Racing. The number of buoys in the star around P may be reduced by decision of the Sailing Committee. The numbering of the star buoys will start at 1, to the North, and run anti Clockwise.

Marks 1,2,3,4,5,6 and P will be large **black** drum buoys.

In addition, temporary round buoys may be used, **"X" which is Yellow** and **"Y" which is Orange**.
